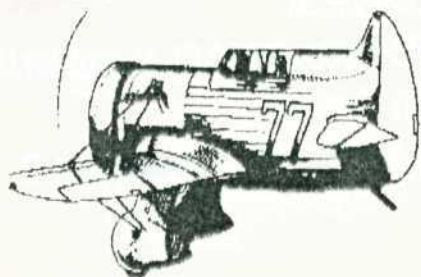
THE FLYING KNIGHTS 30TH ANNIVERSARY NOTES
